AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-a, article seven, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to hunting and fishing licenses for members of the armed forces.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-a, article seven, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. Hunting and Fishing Licenses Not Required

- 2 Of Members Of Armed Forces Who Are Residents Of
- 3 This State.—All residents of West Virginia on active duty
- 4 in the armed forces of the United States of America,

- 5 while on leave or furlough, shall have the right and privi-
- 6 lege to hunt and fish in season in West Virginia. Leave
- 7 or furlough papers shall serve in lieu of hunting and
- 8 fishing licenses and shall be carried on the person at all
- 9 times while hunting or fishing.
