**Senate Bill No. 316**

(By MR. JONES)

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[Passed March 13, 1953; in effect ninety days from passage.]

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AN ACT to authorize and empower the county court of Mason county to set up a courthouse and jail building fund from surpluses thus far accumulated by the said county court and now retained in general county fund, and in county courthouse and jail building fund authorized by chapter two hundred ten, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one, and also from surpluses which may accumulate in the general county fund for five years beginning with the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred fifty-three—one thousand nine hundred fifty-four, and to transfer from the general county fund any money therein thus far accumulated, or that

money hereafter accumulated for five years beginning with the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred fifty-three—one thousand nine hundred fifty-four, over and above the normal operation of said county and to hold and accumulate said money until the fiscal year one thousand nine hundred fifty-seven—one thousand nine hundred fifty-eight, which said money so set up in said special fund may be used for enlarging, remodeling, and improving the present courthouse and jail or for the construction of a new courthouse and jail on the present or another site and as well to purchase additional land from individuals, associations, or corporations, incident to the improvement of said courthouse and jail facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Authorizing Mason County to Transfer From  
2 Its General County Fund And From the County Court-  
3 house and Jail Building Fund Authorized by Chapter  
4 Two Hundred Ten, Acts of the Legislature, Regular Ses-  
5 sion, One Thousand Nine Hundred Fifty-one, All of the  
6 Presently Accumulated Surpluses and All Surpluses  
7 Which May Accumulate for Five Years Beginning With*

8 *the Fiscal Year 1953-1954, Into a Courthouse and Jail*  
9 *Building Fund and Authorizing the County Court of*  
10 *Mason County to Hold and Accumulate Said Surpluses*  
11 *Until the Fiscal Year 1957-1958, and to Spend the Same*  
12 *for Enlarging, Remodeling and Improving the Present*  
13 *Courthouse and Jail, or for the Construction of a New*  
14 *One, or for the Purchase of Additional Real Estate There-*  
15 *for.*—The county court of Mason county is hereby au-  
16 thorized and empowered to transfer from its general  
17 county fund and from the county courthouse and jail  
18 building fund authorized by chapter two hundred ten, acts  
19 of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hun-  
20 dred fifty-one, all money or moneys therein and heretofore  
21 accumulated and held in said fund for building pur-  
22 poses, into a special courthouse and jail building fund  
23 account and is further authorized and empowered from  
24 year to year until the fiscal year one thousand nine hun-  
25 dred fifty-seven—one thousand nine hundred fifty-eight  
26 to transfer from its general county fund into said special  
27 county fund all surpluses that may accumulate in said  
28 general fund, and it is further authorized and empow-

29 ered to hold and accumulate said surpluses until the  
30 fiscal year one thousand nine hundred fifty-seven—one  
31 thousand nine hundred fifty-eight, and that said money  
32 or moneys so accumulated in said special fund may be  
33 expended for the enlarging, remodeling and improving  
34 of the present courthouse and jail, or for the construc-  
35 tion of a new one on the present courthouse site or on  
36 other presently owned county sites and that a portion  
37 of said funds may be used for the purpose of acquiring  
38 additional real estate, either by purchase or through  
39 eminent domain, incident to presently owned county  
40 sites that may be needed for the purpose of enlarging the  
41 same sufficient to accommodate the construction of new  
42 courthouse and jail facilities.
