AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, chapter one hundred ninety-seven, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one, providing for an extension of the limitation of time for filing applications for veterans bonus.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section five, chapter one hundred ninety-seven, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 5. Limitation on Time for Filing Application.—

2 No bonus shall be paid to any person otherwise entitled

- 3 thereto unless application therefor shall be filed with the
- 4 department on or before the thirtieth day of June, one
- 5 thousand nine hundred fifty-three, except that a person
- 6 otherwise entitled thereto may apply for and be paid
- 7 the bonus, if his failure to apply for the same was due
- 8 to his being a prisoner of war in Korea, or to other sim-
- 9 ilar circumstances and events which, in the opinion of
- 10 the director of the West Virginia department of veterans
- 11 affairs, were beyond the control of the said veteran.
