AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state
and its agencies to be moral obligations of the state, and
directing the auditor to issue warrants for the payment
thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Finding and Declaring Certain Claims*
2 *Against the State Road Commission, the State Auditor,*
3 *the State Department of Archives and History, the State*
4 *Adjutant General, the State Board of Control and the*
5 *State Conservation Commission to be Moral Obligations*
6 *of the State, and Directing Payment Thereof.—The Legis-*

7 lature has considered the findings of fact and recom-
8 mendations reported to it by the court of claims
9 concerning various claims against the state and the agen-
10 cies thereof, and in respect to each of the following
11 claims the Legislature adopts those findings of fact as its
12 own, and hereby declares it to be the moral obligation
13 of the state to pay each such claim in the amount speci-
14 fied below, and directs the auditor to issue warrants
15 for the payment thereof out of any fund appropriated
16 and available for the purpose.






