## Senate Bill No. 73

(Originating in the Committee on Finance.)

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[Passed March 12, 1953; in effect July 1, 1953.]

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AN ACT to amend and reenact section two-a, article seven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to sick leave compensation for teachers.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section two-a, article seven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2-a. *Sick Leave Compensation*.—Any county

2 board of education may establish and maintain in its

3 annual budget a separate fund to be known as the  
4 "teachers' sick leave fund".


5 Any full-time teacher employed by a county board of  
6 education that establishes such fund shall be entitled to  
7 at least five days' sick leave per year, cumulative to a  
8 total of twenty days. Money allocated to the sick leave  
9 fund shall be used to pay the salary of all full-time  
10 teachers for time lost from assigned duties due to per-  
11 sonal accident or sickness.

12 All sick leave benefits shall be paid at the end of each  
13 school year. If funds budgeted for sick leave are insuf-  
14 ficient to pay the amount due, the per diem salaries for  
15 all teachers claiming sick leave benefits shall be reduced  
16 proportionately. The board shall carry over from year  
17 to year the accumulated balance in the sick leave fund.  
18 The board is authorized to prescribe such other regula-  
19 tions as it may deem necessary.

20 All moneys received by a county board of education  
21 from any appropriation made by the Legislature for sick  
22 leave benefits, if not used for the purposes of this sec-  
23 tion, may be expended only to provide salary increases

24 for existing teachers, to pay the salaries of necessary ad-  
25 ditional teachers, or if so required to pay the legal min-  
26 imum salaries of existing teachers.






