AN ACT to amend article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirty-four, relating to compensation for suppression of fires on school property.

That article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section thirty-four, to read as follows:

Section 34. Payment for Fire Services; Public School

- 2 Property.—Where a fire company or fire department neces-
- 3 sarily renders services in preventing or extinguishing
- 4 fires upon public school property situated beyond their

- 6 may pay, as a consideration for said services, a reasonable
- 7 compensation to such fire company or fire department and
- 8 such expenditures therefor shall be made from the general
