

## ENROLLED House Bill No. 344

(By Mr. PARKER)

[Passed March 4, 1953; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-d, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to terms of the circuit court in the fourth circuit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-d, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1-d. Fourth Circuit.—For the county of Wood,
on the fourth Monday in January and April, on the second
Monday in July, and the second Monday in October.

4 For the county of Wirt, on the first Monday in January5 and June, and the second Monday in September.
