# ENROLLED <br> Senate Bill No. 165 

(By Mr. McKown)
|Passed February 2G, 1953; in effect July 1, 1953.」

AN ACT to amend article eleven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, to be designated section five-a, relating to the authority of the board of governors to grant sabbatical leaves to faculty members of institutions under its control.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
That article eleven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, to be designated section five-a, to read as follows:

Section 5-a. Authority to Grant Sabbatical Leaves.-
2 The board of governors of West Virginia University shall

5 the purpose of permitting them to engage in graduate 6 study, research or other activities calculated to improve 7 their teaching ability. Such leaves shall be granted only 8 in conformity with a uniform plan adopted by the board 9 and shall be subject to such reasonable rules and regula10 tions as the board may prescribe. Any plan adopted by 11 the board shall not provide for the granting of sabbatical

12 leave to any faculty member who has served less than 13 six years at the institution where he is employed, nor 14 shall such leave be for more than one semester at full 15 pay or two semesters at half pay. Any faculty member 16 receiving a sabbatical leave shall be required to return 17 and serve for at least three years at the institution from 18 which he was granted the leave or to repay to the in19 stitution the compensation received by him during his 20 leave. Compensation to a faculty member on sabbatical

21 leave shall be paid from the regular personal services
22 appropriation of the institution where he is employed.
