AN ACT to amend article ten, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, to be designated section three-a, relating to the registration of antique motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article ten, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, to be designated section three-a, to read as follows:

Section 3-A. *Special Registration of Antique Motor Vehicles.*—The annual registration fee for any antique motor

3 vehicle as defined in this section shall be two dollars.
4 "Antique motor vehicle" shall mean any motor vehicle
5 which is over twenty-five years old, and is owned solely
6 as a collector's item and for participation in club activi-
7 ties, exhibitions, tours, parades and similar uses, but in
8 no event to be used for general transportation.
