## ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 74

(By MR. MARTIN)

[Passed March 14, 1953; in effect July 1, 1953.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to salaries of judges of circuit courts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four, article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 4. Salaries of Judges of Circuit Courts; Addi-2 tional Compensation from Counties.—The salaries of the 3 judges of the circuit courts shall be paid out of the state 4 treasury and shall, unless otherwise provided by law, be 5 in the following annual amounts: Enr. S. B. No. 74]

6 (1) In circuits having more than one hundred thou-7 sand population, eleven thousand dollars;

8 (2) In circuits having more than eighty thousand and
9 less than one hundred thousand population, ten thousand
10 dollars;

(3) In circuits having more than sixty thousand and
less than eighty thousand population, nine thousand five
hundred dollars;

14 (4) In circuits having less than sixty thousand popu-15 lation, nine thousand dollars.

16 Any county court or the board of county commissioners 17 of Ohio county may pay the judge of the circuit court 18 additional compensation, but the salary and additional 19 compensation or combined contribution of the several 20 county courts and board of commissioners shall not ex-21 ceed seventeen thousand dollars.

The population shall be according to the United States census, or the estimate of the United States bureau of census; as certified to the state auditor by the United States director of the census, last preceding the beginning of the calendar year in which the salary is payable. The Joint Committee on Enrolled Bills hereby certifies that the foregoing bill is correctly enrolled.


