AN ACT to amend chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new article, to be numbered article twenty, relating to the right of other states and their political subdivisions to sue in the courts of West Virginia to recover taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new article, numbered twenty, to read as follows:

Section 1. *Authority of Other States and Their Political*

2 *Subdivisions to Sue.*—Any state of the United States, or  
3 any political subdivision thereof, shall have the right to  
4 sue in the courts of West Virginia to recover any tax

5 which may be owing to it when the like right is accorded  
6 to the state of West Virginia and its political subdivisions  
7 by such state, whether such right is granted by statute or  
8 as a matter of comity.
