House Bill No. 170

(By Mr. Bowles)

[Passed March 9, 1955; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section fourteen, article one, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to cooperation by the state board of health with the federal government in survey and construction programs for hospitals and other health facilities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section fourteen, article one, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 14. Board of Health Authorized to Cooperate

- 2 with Federal Government in Hospital and Other Health
- 3 Facility Programs; Advisory Council.—The state board
- 4 of health is hereby designated as the sole state agency
- 5 to cooperate with the federal government in its pro-

6 grams for construction of public or private hospitals, 7 diagnostic or treatment centers, chronic disease hospitals, 8 rehabilitation facilities, nursing homes, and similar or re-9 lated facilities and institutions; and is hereby designated 10 as the sole state agency authorized to make such inven-11 tories of existing public health centers, public and private 12 hospitals, diagnostic or treatment centers, chronic disease 13 hospitals, rehabilitation facilities, nursing homes, and 14 similar or related facilities and institutions, and the lab-15 oratory and other facilities thereof, to make surveys of 16 the need for construction of such health facilities, and to adopt, develop, and supervise the administration of such state wide plans or programs for the construction of additional public and private hospitals, public health centers, public or private diagnostic or treatment centers, chronic 20 disease hospitals, rehabilitation facilities, nursing homes, and similar or related facilities and institutions, as may 22 23 be necessary to comply with the requirements and conditions of federal law in respect to the granting of federal 25 aid for such purposes under all acts of Congress now in

- 26 force and all subsequent acts of Congress amending or
- 27 supplementing those acts of Congress now in force.
- 28 The governor shall have authority to appoint such an
- 29 advisory council to consult with the state board of health
- 30 as may be necessary under federal law to effectuate the
- 31 purposes of this section. The members of any such ad-
- 32 visory council shall serve without compensation, but shall
- 33 be paid the amount of their traveling and other expenses
- 34 necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties.
