AN ACT to amend and reenact section one-a, article four-a, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the financing of municipal parking facilities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one-a, article four-a, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1-a. Municipal Parking Facilities.—Every mu-

- 2 nicipality shall have the authority to establish, operate
- 3 and finance under the provisions of this article automobile
- 4 parking facilities, including building, lots and other facili-
- 5 ties appropriate for that purpose and such facilities shall
- 6 be public works within the meaning of this article.
- 7 Whenever any municipality shall establish any such

- 8 parking facility, then in order to help finance the same,
- 9 such municipality shall have the authority to use any
- 10 revenue derived from parking meters or other parking
- 11 facilities, unless such revenue is otherwise pledged to pay
- 12 for such meters or parking facilities.
