House Bill No. 321

(By MR. RICHARDSON, of Mercer)

[Passed March 10, 1955; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize Concord college to expend from the special improvement fund, established by chapter fifty-one, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-five, the sum of four hundred dollars for the purpose of miscellaneous repairs and alterations on the campus of Concord college.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Expenditure for Miscellaneous Repairs and*

2 *Alterations.*—Concord college is hereby authorized to ex-
3 pend from the special improvement fund, established by
4 chapter fifty-one, acts of the Legislature, regular session,
5 one thousand nine hundred thirty-five, the sum of four
6 hundred dollars for the purpose of miscellaneous repairs
7 and alterations on the campus of Concord college: *Pro-*

8 *vided, however,* That this authorization shall expire June

9 thirtieth, one thousand nine hundred fifty-five.


