AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, chapter one hundred ninety-seven, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one, as amended, providing for an extension of the limitation of time for filing applications for the World War I and World War II veterans bonus. Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section five, chapter one hundred ninety-seven, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 5. Limitation on Time for Filing Application.— 2 No bonus shall be paid to any person otherwise entitled 3 thereto unless application therefor shall be filed with the 4 department on or before the thirty-first day of December 5 one thousand nine hundred fifty-five. Enr. H. B. No. 383]
