AN ACT to amend and reenact section eleven, article one, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the resignation and removal of national guard officers.


Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:


That section eleven, article one, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 11. *Resignation of Officers; Removal.*—No resignation shall be accepted unless the officer tendering the same shall furnish to the adjutant general a certificate from each property accounting officer that he has delivered all books and other property of the state in his possession to the officer authorized to receive the same, and that his accounts for money or public property are correct, and

8 that he is not indebted to the state or federal military
9 authorities. No commissioned officer shall be removed
10 from office, unless by the senate on recommendation of
11 the governor, stating the grounds on which such removal
12 is recommended, or by the decision of a court-martial, or
13 an examining board, or as provided in federal laws or
14 regulations pertaining to the national guard or air national
15 guard, or pursuant to law.



Chairman Senate Committee



Chairman House Committee


