[Passed March 12, 1955; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article seven, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the collection of municipal taxes, fines and assessments.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article seven, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2. *Collection of Municipal Taxes, Fines and Assessments; Duties of Sergeant.*—It shall be the duty of the sergeant or such other officer as may be designated by the municipal council to collect and promptly pay into the treasury all taxes, special assessments, fines and other moneys due the municipality. All taxes, special assessments (except assessments for permanent or semi-

8 permanent public improvements), fines and other moneys
9 due the municipality are hereby declared to be debts
10 owing to the municipality, for which the debtor shall be
11 personally liable, and the sergeant or other officer may
12 enforce this liability by appropriate action including an
13 action in assumpsit or notice of motion for judgment, in
14 any court of competent jurisdiction, and is hereby vested
15 with the same rights to distrain for the same as is vested
16 in the sheriff for the collection of taxes. Such officer shall
17 give bond, conditioned according to law, in such penalty
18 and with such security as the council may require.



Chairman Senate Committee






