## Senate Bill No. 302

(By Mr. SMITH)

[Passed March 11, 1955; in effect July 1, 1955.]

AN ACT finding and declaring the claim of Bobby Joe Edmonds an infant, against the state of West Virginia and its agency, the state road commission, to be a moral obligation of the state and directing the auditor to issue a warrant for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Finding and Declaring the Payment of the

- 6 ported to it by the attorney general of the State of West

7 Virginia, concerning the claim of Bobby Joe Edmonds, an infant, for personal injuries occasioned by the said claimant on October twenty-third, one thousand nine hundred fifty-two, as a direct result of the negligence of employees 11 of the state road commission in permitting gasoline to 12 remain open and unguarded in an empty bucket on Fourth 13 Avenue, a public street in the city of Huntington, West Virginia, where children, including the claimant, were 15 rightfully playing and that this gasoline was ignited and caused severe burns to the right leg of the claimant, causing him permanent injuries and necessitating skin grafting, medical and hospital expense, and in respect to the said claim the Legislature declares it to be the moral obligation of the state to pay the said claim of Bobby Joe 20 Edmonds in the amount of one thousand five hundred 22 dollars and hereby directs the auditor to issue a warrant 23 for the payment thereof.
