AN ACT to amend and reenact section twenty-two, article five, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the powers of the director of the budget in the administration of expenditures.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section twenty-two, article five, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows: Section 22. Powers of the Director in the Administra-

- 2 tion of Expenditures.—The director shall supervise and
- 3 control the expenditure of appropriations made by the
- 4 Legislature except those made to the Legislature and
- 5 those made to the judicial branch of the state govern-
- 6 ment. The expenditure of an appropriation made by
- 7 the Legislature shall be conditioned upon compliance
- 8 by the spending unit with the provisions of this article.
- 9 An appropriation made by the Legislature shall be ex-
- 10 pended only in accordance with this article.
- 11 For the purposes of budgetary control of expenditures
- 12 under his supervision and control, the director shall con-
- 13 tinually examine the spending methods of all units of
- 14 state government and may require them to answer such
- 15 questions with respect thereto as he may deem necessary.
- 16 Whenever any spending unit submits a requisition for
- 17 any expenditure which, in the opinion of the director,
- 18 is illegal, or unauthorized, or contrary to the intent of
- 19 the Legislature in making the appropriation from which
- 20 the proposed expenditure is to be made, he shall refuse
- 21 to approve the requisition. If the spending unit wishes

- 22 to appeal the decision of the director, the matter shall
- 23 first be submitted to the legislative auditor for his opin-
- 24 ion. If as a result no satisfactory solution is reached, the
- 25 matter shall be submitted to the attorney general for
- 26 his opinion.
