AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article three, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the registration of motor vehicles and to the issuance of certificates of title therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four, article three, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended to read as follows:

Section 4. Application for Certificate of Title; Tax Limi-

- 2 tation.—Certificates of registration of any vehicle or reg-
- 3 istration plates therefor, whether original issue or dupli-

4 cates, shall not be issued or furnished by the department 5 of motor vehicles or any other officer charged with such 6 duty, unless the applicant therefor already has received, 7 or shall at the same time make application for and be granted, an official certificate of title of such vehicle. Such application shall be upon a blank form to be furnished by the department of motor vehicles and shall contain a full description of the vehicle, which description shall contain the manufacturer's serial or identifi-12 cation number or other number as determined by the 13 commissioner and any distinguishing marks, together with a statement of the applicant's title and of any liens or encumbrances upon such vehicles, the names and ad-17 dresses of the holders of such liens and such other information as the department of motor vehicles may require. The application shall be signed and sworn to by the applicant. A tax is hereby imposed upon the privilege of 21 effecting the certification of title of each vehicle in the 22 amount equal to two per cent of the value of said motor 23 vehicle at the time of such certification. If the vehicle is

24 new, the actual purchase price or consideration to the

purchaser thereof shall be the value of said vehicle; if 25 the vehicle is a used or second-hand vehicle, the present 26 market value at time of transfer or purchase shall be 27 deemed the value thereof for the purpose of this section: 28 29 Provided, That so much of the purchase price or consideration as is represented by the exchange of other vehicles 30 on which the tax herein imposed has been paid by the 31 32 purchaser shall be deducted from the total actual price 33 or consideration paid for said vehicle, whether the same 34 be new or second-hand; if the vehicle be acquired through 35 gift, or by any manner whatsoever, unless specifically 36 exempted in this section, the present market value of the 37 vehicle at the time of the gift or transfer shall be deemed 38 the value thereof for purposes of this section. No cer-39 tificate of title for any vehicle shall be issued to any 40 applicant unless such applicant shall have paid to the 41 department of motor vehicles the tax imposed by this section which shall be two per cent of the true and actual 42 43 value of said vehicle whether the vehicle be acquired through purchase, by gift, or by any other manner what-44 soever except gifts and bequests between husband and

46 wife or between parents and children; but the tax im-47 posed by this section shall not apply to vehicles to be 48 registered as class H or class I vehicles, as defined in section one, article ten of this chapter, which are used or to be used in interstate commerce, nor shall the tax im-51 posed by this section apply to titling of vehicles by a 52 registered dealer of this state for resale only, nor shall the 53 tax imposed by this section apply to titling of vehicles by 54 the board of governors, the state board of education, the 55 county boards of education or other public tax supported 56 educational agencies. The total amount of revenue col-57 lected by reason of this tax shall be paid into the state 58 road fund and expended by the state road commission in 59 the maintenance and construction of the state's secondary 60 roads. In addition to said tax, there shall be a charge of 61 one dollar for each original certificate of title so issued: 62 Provided, That the board of governors, the state board 63 of education, the county boards of education or other 64 public tax supported educational agencies, shall be ex-65 empted from payment of such charge.

- Notwithstanding the provisions of this section, the owners of trailers, semi-trailers and other vehicles not subject to the certificate of title tax prior to enactment of this chapter shall not be required to pay the above mentioned tax upon making application for a certificate of title for such vehicle, but shall be required to pay a fee of one dollar for the issuance of each such certificate of title.
- Such certificate shall be good for the life of the vehicle, so long as the same is owned or held by the original holder of such certificate, and need not be renewed annually, or any other time, except as herein provided.
- If, by will or direct inheritance, a person becomes the owner of a motor vehicle upon which the tax herein imposed has been paid, he shall not be required to pay such tax.
- A person who has paid the tax imposed by this section shall not be required to pay the tax a second time for the same motor vehicle, but he shall be required to pay a charge of one dollar for the certificate of re-title of that motor vehicle, except that such tax shall be paid by such
