# EAROLLED <br> House Bill No. 143 

(By Mr. Adams and Mr. Young)
[Passed March 5, 1955; in effect ninety day's from passagc.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article two, chapier two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to legal holidays. Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article two, chapter two of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. Legal Holidays; Official Acts or Court Pro-
2 ceedings.-The following days shall be regarded, treated and observed as legal holidays, viz: The first day of Janu-

4 ary, commonly called "New Year's Day"; the twelfth day
5 of February, commonly called "Lincoln's Birthday"; the
6 twenty-second day of February, commonly called "Wash-
7 ington's Birthday"; the thirtieth day of May, commonly
8 called "Memorial Day"; the twentieth day of June, com-

9 monly called "West Virginia Day"; the fourth day of 10 July, commonly called "Independence Day"; the first

11 Monday in September, commonly called "Labor Day";
12 the twelfth day of October, commonly called "Columbus
13 Day"; the eleventh day of November, commonly called 14 "Veterans Day"; the twenty-fifth day of December, com-

15 monly called "Christmas Day"; any national, state or other 16 election day throughout the district or municipality 17 wherein held; and all days that may be appointed or 18 recommended by the governor of this state, or the presi19 dent of the United States, as days of thanksgiving, or

20 for the general cessation of business; and when any of
21 said days or dates falls on Sunday, then it shall be lawful 22 to observe the succeeding Monday as such holiday. When

23 the return day of any summons or other court proceedings
24 or any notice or time fixed for holding any court or doing 25 any official act shall fall on any of said holidays, the ensu-

26 ing secular day shall be taken as meant and intended.
