

ENROLLED House Bill No. 291

(By MR. McLaughlin)

[Passed March 7, 1955; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article two, chapter fourteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section twelve, relating to claims against the state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article two, chapter fourteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section twelve, to read as follows:

Section 12. Process, Payment.—The attorney general 2 shall have authority to subpoena witnesses to attend hear-3 ings and place them under oath when testifying: Pro-4 vided, however, That all the expenses involved in com-5 pelling a witness to attend a hearing shall be borne by Enr. H. B. No. 291] 2
