AN ACT to repeal section three, article five, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the hunting of wood ducks.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article five, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be and the same is, hereby repealed.
