AN ACT to repeal article eighteen, chapter eighteen of the code  
of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one,  
as amended, relating to the West Virginia School for the  
Colored Deaf and Blind.

That article eighteen, chapter eighteen of the code of West  
Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended,  
be repealed.






