## Senate Bill No. 63

(By Mr. Amos)

(By request of the Department of Motor Vehicles.)

[Passed February 18, 1955; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section eight, article ten, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to exemption from registration fees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eight, article ten, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 8. Exemption From Registration Fees.—The
2 United States government, the state, or any political sub-

division thereof, shall be exempted from the payment of any fee on account of registration of any vehicle owned or operated by the United States government, the state, or any political subdivision thereof, as the case may be: 7 Provided, That the proper representative of the federal government, the state, or any such political subdivision thereof, shall make, or cause to be made, on the form provided for that purpose, an application for registration 10 of such vehicle so owned and operated, and that the registration plate or plates issued for such vehicle shall be displayed or caused to be displayed as provided in this 13 chapter: Provided further, That fire apparatus owned by the United States government, the state, or any political subdivision thereof, and by an incorporated volunteer fire department organized for protection of community prop-17 erty shall be exempt from all the provisions of this article, 18 pertaining to the payment of registration fees: Provided 19 20 further, That any ambulance used exclusively for charitable purposes, for which use there is no charge, shall be exempt from the payment of all registration fees required 22 23 by this article: And Provided further, That any disabled veteran owning an automobile under the provisions of
Public Law 663 of the 79th Congress of the United
States or Public Law 187 of the 82nd Congress of the
United States shall be exempt from the payment of any
fee on account of registration of any vehicle owned by
such disabled veteran. This exemption shall not apply to
such disabled veterans owning vehicles used for hire, but
such exemption shall be in force and effect for such
passenger car vehicles owned by such disabled veterans
during their natural life.
