AN ACT to repeal article nine, chapter twenty-nine of the code
of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one,
as amended, relating to the West Virginia industrial and
publicity commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Repeal.*—Article nine, chapter twenty-nine
2 of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred
3 thirty-one, as amended, is hereby repealed.
