(By MR. RAGLAND)

[Passed March 4, 1957; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section nine, chapter two hundred five, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-five, fixing the salary of the judge of the criminal court of Raleigh county.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section nine, chapter two hundred five, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-five, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 9. *Salary of the Judge of the Criminal Court of Raleigh County.*—The judge of the criminal court of Raleigh county, West Virginia, shall from and after the first day of January, one thousand nine hundred sixty-three, receive for his services a salary in the amount of nine thousand dollars per annum, to be paid in monthly installments out of the county treasury of Raleigh county,

8 out of funds of said treasury, in the manner provided by  
9 statute.
