Senate Bill No. 250

(By MR. MARTIN)

[Passed February 22, 1957; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact chapter one hundred seventy-nine, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-five, authorizing the county court of Berkeley county to transfer unexpended funds and surpluses in any funds of said county into a fund to be used and expended by the county court for county fire protection equipment, apparatus and facilities and county courthouse and jail repairs, improvements and additions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That chapter one hundred seventy-nine, acts of the Legislature of West Virginia, regular session, one thousand nine hundred fifty-five, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 1. *Berkeley County Unexpended and Surplus*
2 *Funds; Use and Disposition for Fire Protection and Court-*
3 *house and Jail Improvements.*—Subject to the use and
4 allocation of available moneys and funds, as provided in
5 section two hereof, the county court of Berkeley county
6 is hereby authorized and empowered to use any unexpen-
7 ded funds of said county and any surplus in any county
8 fund, now or hereafter created, for the purpose of pur-
9 chasing, operating and maintaining fire apparatus and
10 equipment of all kinds used in furnishing fire protection,
11 and is hereby further authorized and empowered to place
12 or station such equipment and apparatus under the juris-
13 diction and control of the city council of the city of Mar-
14 tinsburg for the operation thereof. The county court of
15 Berkeley county is also hereby authorized and empowered
16 to use any such unexpended funds and surplus in an
17 amount necessary for the rental of fire hydrants erected
18 and maintained by any municipal corporation and/or
19 sanitary district in said county. The authority hereby
20 granted is in addition to the authority granted by chap-

21 ter one hundred thirty-seven, acts of the Legislature,
22 regular session, one thousand nine hundred forty-nine.

Sec. 2. *Use of Funds for Courthouse and Jail Repairs,*
2 *Improvements and Additions; Apportionment of Funds;*
3 *Expenditure.*—The county court of Berkeley county may,
4 in its discretion, allocate the available moneys and funds,
5 as provided in section one of this chapter, for such fire
6 protection uses and services as it may find to be expedient
7 and practicable and is hereby authorized and empowered
8 to use and expend the balance of all such available mon-
9 eys and funds for repairs, improvements and additions
10 to the courthouse and jail of Berkeley county. Such avail-
11 able moneys and funds may be used and expended for
12 necessary or emergency repairs or improvements to the
13 courthouse or jail and may be accumulated for other
14 repairs and improvements and structural additions to the
15 courthouse and jail of Berkeley county: *Provided, how-*
16 *ever,* That such moneys and funds may also, in the discre-
17 tion of said court, be used or expended for the construc-
18 tion and/or purchase of an annex to said courthouse or
19 the construction and/or purchase of a new courthouse.
