**Senate Bill No. 75**  
(By MR. PARKER)

[Passed February 6, 1957; in effect 90 days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article nine, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section nineteen, relating to the disposition of funds received from the federal government on account of the leasing of lands for flood control, navigation, and allied purposes.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article nine, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section nineteen, to read as follows:

Section 19. *Disposition of Flood Control, Navigation,  
2 and Allied Funds from the Federal Government.*—Re-

3 cepts from the treasurer of the United States, paid to the  
4 state or its proper officers pursuant to direction of an act  
5 of Congress relating to disposition of funds received on  
6 account of the leasing of lands for flood control, naviga-  
7 tion, and allied purposes, shall be allocated by the state  
8 auditor to each county in accordance with the method of  
9 allocation specified by the federal government. The state  
10 auditor shall transfer to the road commission fifty per  
11 cent of the funds so allocated to each county for the pur-  
12 pose of maintenance of secondary roads in the area or  
13 areas of the county in which such flooded lands are  
14 located. Fifty per cent of the funds so allocated to any  
15 county in which such lands are located shall be paid by  
16 the state auditor to the board of education of that county  
17 to be expended by the board for the benefit of the public  
18 schools of the county.
