## ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 323

(Originating in the Committee on Finance)
[Passed March 5, 1957; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, article one-a, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the establishment, maintenance, and operation of book stores at state educational institutions and to the disposition of revenues derived therefrom.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:
That section five, article one-a, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 5. Establishment, Maintenance, and Operation
2 of Book Stores at State Educational Institutions; Disposi-
3 tion of Revenues.-The governing board of each state edu-
4 cational institution shall have the authority to establish

7 cluding each of its schools and departments, in making 8 purchases of books, stationery and other school and office 9 supplies generally carried in college stores, and for the

22 All moneys derived from the operation of the store shall

23 be paid into a special revenue fund as provided in section
24 two, article two, chapter twelve of this code. The govern-
25 ing board shall, subject to the approval of the governor,

26 fix and from time to time change the amount of the re27 volving fund necessary for the proper and efficient opera28 tion of each book store. Whenever at the end of any fiscal 29 year the unencumbered balance in the book store special 30 revenue fund shall exceed the amount of the revolving 31 fund so established, the excess shall be transferred by the 32 state auditor to the general revenue fund and become a 33 part of the general revenue of the state.

34 Moneys derived from the operation of the book store 35 shall be used first to replenish the stock of goods and to

44 in fixing the amount of the revolving fund for the university book store.
