[Passed February 4, 1957; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact sections ten and eleven, article four, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to dismantling or wrecking titled vehicles.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That sections ten and eleven, article four, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 10. *Owner Dismantling or Wrecking Vehicle to*
2 *Return Evidence of Ownership.*—Any owner dismantling
3 or wrecking any titled vehicle shall immediately for-

4 ward to the department the certificate of title for such
5 vehicle with the word "scrapped" or word or words of
6 similar meaning written across the face thereof.

Sec. 11. *Sale of Motor Vehicle to Be Dismantled.*—Any
2 owner who sells a titled vehicle as scrap or to be dis-
3 mantled or destroyed shall assign the certificate of title
4 thereto to the purchaser who shall deliver such certifi-
5 cate so assigned to the department with the word "scrap-
6 ped" or word or words of similar meaning written across
7 the face thereof: *Provided*, That if the purchaser so
8 desires, he may obtain from the department a permit to
9 dismantle or scrap such vehicle by executing an applica-
10 tion for such permit and delivering same to the depart-
11 ment with the certificate of title so assigned. The de-
12 partment shall thereupon issue to the purchaser a permit
13 to dismantle the vehicle which shall authorize such per-
14 son to possess or transport such motor vehicle or to
15 transfer ownership thereto by endorsement upon such
16 permit. A certificate of title shall not again be issued for
17 such motor vehicle in the event it is scrapped, dismantled,
18 or destroyed.
