Senate Bill No. 61

(By MR. TAYLOR AND MR. BOWERS)

[Passed February 12, 1957; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to filling vacancies on county boards of education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article five, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2. *Filling Vacancies.*—The board shall, by appointment, fill within thirty days any vacancy that occurs in its membership. Such appointments shall continue until the next primary or general election, which-

5 ever may first occur, when the voters shall elect a suc-
6 cessor for the unexpired term. In the event that the
7 board does not fill the vacancy within thirty days, the
8 state superintendent of schools shall appoint a person
9 to fill the vacancy: *Provided, however,* That should a
10 vacancy occur less than forty-two days next preceding
11 any primary or general election, such vacancy shall not be
12 filled by election until the next succeeding primary or
13 general election, whichever may first occur.
