## House Bill No. 165

(By Mr. Singleton)

[Passed February 24, 1959; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section eight, article six-a, chapter three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to absentee voting by members of armed services, their spouses and members of their family.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eight, article six-a, chapter three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 8. Persons Entitled to Vote Under the Pro-

- 2 visions of This Article.—Any person, man or woman, who
- 3 is registered as a voter in any county of this state, who is
- 4 a member of any branch of the armed services of the
- 5 United States, and who in the performance of his duties
- 6 expects to be absent on election day from the county

- 7 in which he is registered, or his wife or husband, or other
- 8 member of his family living with such person, may vote
- 9 by absent voter's ballot as provided in this article, whether
- 10 such person at the time of voting is within or without the
- 11 territorial limits of the United States.
- 12 Any other person may vote by absent voter's ballot only
- 13 as provided in article six, chapter three of this code.
