AN ACT to authorize the county court of Mingo county to transfer the sum of thirteen thousand three hundred dollars from the general fund to a "Special Armory Fund" for the purpose of paying a portion of the deferred purchase money upon the acquisition of five and one tenth acres in West Williamson within the city of Williamson, Mingo county, West Virginia, by the Tug Valley industrial corporation and by it conveyed unto the state of West Virginia for the use and benefit of the state armory board, upon which said tract the said state armory board, with the aid of federal funds, is constructing a modern armory and community building.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Mingo County Authorized to Transfer*  
2 *Thirteen Thousand Three Hundred Dollars to "Special*

3 *Armory Fund" to Pay Deferred Purchase Money Upon*  
4 *Land Acquired by the State of West Virginia for Benefit*  
5 *of State Armory Board.*—The county court of Mingo  
6 county, is hereby authorized to transfer from the general  
7 fund the sum of thirteen thousand three hundred dollars  
8 to a "Special Armory Fund" for the purpose of paying a  
9 portion of the deferred purchase money upon the acqui-  
10 sition of five and one tenth acres in West Williamson within  
11 the city of Williamson, Mingo county, West Virginia, by  
12 the Tug Valley industrial corporation and by it conveyed  
13 unto the state of West Virginia, for the use and benefit of  
14 the state armory board, <sup>which</sup> with the aid of federal funds, is  
15 constructing a modern armory and community building.




