[Passed February 24, 1959; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the county court of Gilmer county to use unexpended funds and surpluses in any funds of said county, up to the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars, for the purpose of creating a special building fund for the building and equipping of a dining hall at the Gilmer county recreation center and to expend for such purposes the fund so created.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Gilmer County Court Authorized to Create a Special Building Fund.*—The county court of Gilmer county is hereby authorized and empowered from year to year to use any unexpended funds of said county and any surplus of any funds, up to the sum of twenty-two thousand dollars, for the purpose of creating a special building fund for the building and equipping of a dining hall at

10 so created.




