AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article one-a, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the collection and expenditure of athletic receipts at state educational institutions.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section two, article one-a, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2. *Fees and Money Derived from Athletic Contests; Collection and Expenditure Thereof.*—The directors of athletics at state educational institutions may fix and charge admission fees to athletic contests at state educational institutions and may enter into contracts, spend and receive money under such contracts for the student

7 athletic teams of state educational institutions to contest  
8 with other athletic teams inside or outside the state.

9 All money derived from such fees and under such con-  
10 tracts shall be used to defray the cost of maintaining the  
11 athletic department and athletic program of such insti-  
12 tutions. The operation of training camps and training  
13 tables for participants in the athletic program of such  
14 institutions shall be recognized and considered as a proper  
15 part of such maintenance, but the specific mention of  
16 training camps and training tables shall not be construed  
17 or understood to limit in any way the general power and  
18 authority otherwise granted and conferred by this section.
