AN ACT to authorize the county court of Raleigh county to appropriate funds to be expended for the purpose of establishing an office and to provide personnel to carry out a program conducted by the Beckley area rural development council.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. *Raleigh County Court Authorized to Appropriate and Expend Funds to be Used in a Program Conducted by the Beckley Area Rural Development Council; Power to Levy Therefor.*—In order to assist in the development of agriculture, in the development of community improvement programs, in the establishment of sanitary land fills for the disposal of trash and garbage and in other programs carried on and conducted by the Beckley area rural development council, the county court of

10 Raleigh county is hereby authorized and empowered to  
11 appropriate and expend funds for the purpose of establish-  
12 ing an office and providing personnel to carry out the  
13 above functions. The county court of Raleigh county is  
14 authorized to levy for the purpose of obtaining the money  
15 for expenditures made under this section.
