House Bill No. 41

(By MR. GOSHORN)

[Passed February 12, 1959; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, article four, chapter sixty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to forging or uttering other writings; penalty.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section five, article four, chapter sixty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 5. *Forging or Uttering Other Writing; Penalty.*

2 —If any person forge any writing, other than such as is
3 mentioned in the first and third sections of this article,
4 to the prejudice of another's right, or utter or attempt to
5 employ as true such forged writing, knowing it to be
6 forged, he shall be deemed guilty of a felony, and upon
7 conviction, shall be confined in the penitentiary not less

8 than one nor more than ten years, or, in the discretion of
9 the court, be confined in jail not more than one year and
10 be fined not exceeding five hundred dollars.
