Senate Bill No. 192
(By MR. NUCKOLS)

[Passed March 4, 1959; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article seventeen, chapter thirty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section designated section eleven, relating to the exclusion of insurance coverage for nuclear reaction, nuclear radiation or radioactive contamination.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article seventeen, chapter thirty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section designated section eleven, to read as follows:

Section 11. *Exclusion of Nuclear Perils.*—Insurers issuing the standard policy pursuant to section two of any

3 permissible variation thereof are authorized to affix
4 thereto or include therein a written statement that the
5 policy does not cover loss or damage caused by nuclear
6 reaction, nuclear radiation or radioactive contamination,
7 or any combination or all of said causes, whether directly
8 or indirectly resulting from an insured peril under said
9 policy: *Provided, however,* That nothing therein con-
10 tained shall be construed to prohibit the attachment to
11 any such policy of an endorsement or endorsements spe-
12 cifically assuming coverage for loss or damage caused by
13 nuclear reaction, nuclear radiation or radioactive con-
14 tamination.
