AN ACT to amend and reenact section twenty-three, article eleven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the authority of the board of governors of West Virginia university with respect to the administration and use of the contractual research revolving fund heretofore established.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section twenty-three, article eleven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 23. *Contractual Research Revolving Fund.*—

2 For the purpose of promoting and financing scientific and

3 other research at West Virginia university, the contract-
4 ual research revolving fund heretofore created as a special
5 fund in the state treasury shall be continued. The fund
6 shall be administered by the board of governors as fol-
7 lows:

8 (1) The moneys in the fund shall be used first for ad-
9 vances necessary to finance scientific research under con-
10 tracts made with agencies of the federal government,
11 with state agencies such as the state road commission, the
12 state department of health, the state conservation com-
13 mission, the state department of mines, the state depart-
14 ment of agriculture, or any other state agency authorized
15 to enter into contracts for such research, or with any
16 private corporation, trust or individual. Whenever the
17 board has entered into any such contract, it may authorize
18 expenditure from the fund of such sums as may be needed
19 for performance of the contract. In order to reimburse the
20 fund for such advances, all payments received under any
21 such contract shall be redeposited in the fund. The unex-
22 pended balance in the fund, together with total reimburs-
23 able items payable to the fund under the provisions of this

24 subsection shall never be less than one hundred thousand
25 dollars.

26 (2) Whenever the amount remaining in the revolving
27 fund, together with the reimbursable items specified in
28 the preceding subsection, shall exceed one hundred thou-
29 sand dollars, such excess may be used by the board to
30 finance scientific or other research conducted by the uni-
31 versity, whether under contract or otherwise.

32 (3) In the financing of contract or other research, ex-
33 penditures may be made from the fund for the payment
34 of all expenses needed in the conduct of the research, in-
35 cluding the payment of salaries, reimbursement for neces-
36 sary travel and other expenses, the purchase, rental or
37 repair of equipment, and the purchase of supplies.

38 (4) Any money in the fund not immediately needed
39 for the conduct of research may be temporarily invested
40 by the board.
