(By MR. TRAUBERT AND MR. MOATS)

[Passed March 13, 1959; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two-c, article nine, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to transfer by sheriff of unneeded and unexpended funds collected to retire school bonds; how funds to be used and expended.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two-c, article nine, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2-c. *Transfer by Sheriff of Unneeded and Unexpended Funds Collected to Retire School Bonds; How Funds to Be Used and Expended.*—The sheriffs of the vari-

4 ous counties are hereby authorized and directed to trans-
5 fer to the credit of the school current fund of the boards
6 of education of their respective counties, all remaining
7 funds collected for the retirement of school bonds after
8 such bond shall have been retired, if the fact of such re-
9 tirement has been certified by the state sinking fund
10 commission.

11 When such bond shall have been retired the state sink-
12 ing fund commission shall certify the fact of the retire-
13 ment of such bond to the sheriff and to the board of educa-
14 tion of the county. Such funds shall be used in the same
15 manner as other funds now to the credit of, or which may
16 hereafter be placed to the credit of, the school current
17 fund of the respective boards of education.
