AN ACT to amend and reenact section fourteen, article eight, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to assessments to improve streets, sidewalks and sewers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section fourteen, article eight, chapter eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 14. *Liberal Construction of Article; Validity and*

2 *Enforcement of Assessments.*—This article shall be liber-
3 ally construed to accomplish the purpose of providing
4 reasonable, economical and expeditious means for mu-

5 municipalities to provide permanent improvements and as-
6 sure to the contractors making such improvements, or
7 persons directly or indirectly financing the same, security
8 in the payment of the cost and expense of such improve-
9 ment; and nothing in this article shall be construed as
10 imposing a time limit on the certificate holder for the
11 enforcement of his rights.

12 Moreover, the validity and enforcement of the assess-
13 ments in this article provided shall not be impaired by the
14 issuance and sale of bonds, as provided by chapter thir-
15 teen, article one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand
16 nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, for the same im-
17 provements, nor by the application, in whole or in part,
18 of the proceeds of any such bond issue to the cost of any
19 such improvements prior to collection of said assessments.
