AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, article seven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the payment of teachers and other employees.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section five, article seven, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 5. *Payment of Teachers and Other Employees.*—


- 2 All teachers and employees whose salaries are payable out
- 3 of the school current fund shall be paid for their services
- 4 by orders drawn upon the sheriff or treasurer and duly


5 signed by the president and secretary of the board in ac-  
6 cordance with the following provisions:

7 Notwithstanding any other provisions of this chapter,  
8 all teachers duly contracted shall be paid in not fewer than  
9 nine nor more than twelve monthly pays and on a fixed  
10 and regularly designated date for the calendar month.  
11 Adjustments for time loss due to absence may be made  
12 in the next pay check following such time loss.

13 The board may withhold the monthly salary of any  
14 teacher or employee until he has made the reports re-  
15 quired by the board or the state superintendent.






