AN ACT to amend article two, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section five, relating to contracts between municipalities, counties and boards of education, and local boards of health, for public health services and the use of public health facilities.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article two, chapter sixteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section five, to read as follows:

Section 5. *Contracts for Public Health Services and*  
2 *Facilities.*—Any municipality, county or board of edu-  
3 cation, may contract with any local board of health

4 created, operated or existing under any provision of this  
5 chapter, for the rendering or providing of local health  
6 services or for the use of public health facilities. Any such  
7 contract may provide for payment, by such municipality,  
8 county or board of education, to such local board  
9 of health for such services or the use of such facilities, of  
10 a fixed sum of money on an annual, quarterly, or other  
11 periodic basis.

12 All of such contracts shall be in writing and limited in  
13 duration to not more than one fiscal year, with provision  
14 for renewal, by agreement of the parties, for successive  
15 like periods.
