AN ACT to amend article six, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-a, relating to the operation of vehicles displaying special stickers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article six, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-a, to read as follows:

Section 1-a. Operation of Vehicles under Special Stick-

- 2 ers; Application Therefor and Expiration Thereof.—The
- 3 commissioner may upon application made on a form pre-
- 4 scribed and furnished by the department issue to an in-
- 5 surance company, a finance company or other type of lend-

- 6 ing or financing agency or a person engaged exclusively
- 7 in wrecking or dismantling vehicles, exempted as a dealer
- 8 under the provisions of section twenty-eight, article one,
- 9 a paper sticker or decal to be affixed to the left side of the
- 10 rear window of a motor vehicle or at a place on any other
- 11 type vehicle as designated by the commissioner. Such
- 12 sticker or decal shall be of a size to be designated by the
- 13 commissioner and shall be serially numbered and shall
- 14 have provision thereon to indicate the date of issuance
- 15 thereof. A fee of fifty cents per sticker shall be charged
- 16 by the department to the applicant therefor. Such sticker
- 17 or decal shall be valid for the operation of a vehicle,
- 18 whether under its own power or while being towed, one
- 19 time only over the streets or highways of this state and
- 20 upon being once affixed to a vehicle shall become invalid
- 21 for subsequent use on that or any other vehicle.
- 22 The commissioner is hereby authorized to make neces-
- 23 sary rules and regulations for the administration and en-
- 24 forcement of this section.
