## House Bill No. 313

(By Mr. Baker and Mr. Campbell)

AN ACT to amend article nine, chapter nineteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section twelve-b, relating to the possession, sale, distribution, or administration of unattenuated hog cholera virus. Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article nine, chapter nineteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section twelve-b, to read as follows:

Section 12-b. Possession, Sale, Distribution or Adminis-

- 2 tration of Unattenuated Hog Cholera Virus.—It shall be
- 3 unlawful for any person, firm, corporation or association
- 4 to sell or offer for sale, distribute, administer, barter,
- 5 exchange, give away or otherwise dispose of unattenuated

- 6 hog cholera virus except upon a special written permit
- 7 issued by the commissioner of agriculture.
- 8 "Hog cholera virus" means an unattenuated virus ad-
- 9 ministered to swine for the purpose of immunizing such
- 10 swine against the disease known as hog cholera.
