AN ACT to amend and reenact section two-t, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the terms of court in the twentieth circuit.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two-t, article two, chapter fifty-one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2-t. *Twentieth Circuit.*—For the county of
2 Randolph, on the third Tuesday in September, January
3 and April.
