AN ACT to amend article two-a, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section designated section five, relating to the disposition of funds collected by the medical licensing board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article two-a, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section designated section five, to read as follows:

Section 5. Collections and Expenditures; Disposition of 2 Funds.—All moneys collected by the medical licensing

- 3 board under the provisions of this chapter shall be de-
- 4 posited in the state treasury as provided by law, and shall
- 5 be there credited to a special fund to be known as the
- 6 "Medical Licensing Board Special Fund". All moneys in
- 7 such special fund shall be expended only for the adminis-
- 8 tration of the provisions of this article and for payment
- 9 of costs and expenses necessarily incurred by the board in
- 10 exercising the powers granted to it, and in performing the
- 11 duties imposed upon it by law.
