## Senate Bill No. 20

(By Mr. Bean, Mr. President, and Mr. Carrigan)

[Passed March 13, 1959; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article two, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the method of payment of moneys due the state into the state treasury and the disposition thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article two, chapter twelve of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2. Method of Payment by State Officials and

- 2 Employees; Credit to State Fund; Exceptions.-All offi-
- 3 cials and employees of the state authorized by statute to

- 4 accept moneys due the state of West Virginia shall keep
- 5 a daily itemized record of such moneys so received for
- 6 deposit in the state treasury and shall deposit promptly
- 7 with the state treasurer all moneys received or collected
- 8 by them for or on behalf of the state for any purpose
- 9 whatsoever. When so paid, such moneys shall be credited
- 10 to the state fund and treated by the auditor and treasurer
- 11 as part of the general revenue of the state, and shall not
- 12 be used for any purpose whatsoever unless and until
- 13 authorized and directed by the Legislature, except the
- 14 following funds:
- 15 (a) All moneys received out of appropriations made
- 16 by the congress of the United States;
- 17 (b) All funds derived from the sale of farm and dairy
- 18 products;
- 19 (c) All endowment funds, bequests, donations, execu-
- 20 tive emergency funds, and death and disability funds;
- 21 (d) All fees and funds collected at state educational
- 22 institutions for student activities;
- 23 (e) All funds derived from collections from dormi-
- 24 tories, boarding houses, cafeterias and road camps;

- 25 (f) All moneys received from counties by institutions
- 26 for the deaf and blind on account of clothing for indigent
- 27 pupils;
- 28 (g) All insurance collected on account of losses by fire
- 29 and refunds;
- 30 (h) All funds derived from bookstores and sales of
- 31 blank paper and stationery, and collections by the chief
- 32 inspector of public offices;
- 33 (i) All moneys collected and belonging to the capitol
- 34 building fund, state road fund, state road sinking funds,
- 35 general school fund, school fund, state fund (moneys be-
- 36 longing to counties, districts and municipalities), state
- 37 interest and sinking fund, state compensation funds, the
- 38 fund maintained by the public service commission for the
- 39 investigation and supervision of applications and licenses
- 40 under article nine, chapter thirty-one of this code, and all
- 41 funds and moneys payable to or received by the conserva-
- 42 tion commission of West Virginia;
- 43 (j) All moneys collected or received under any act of
- 44 the Legislature providing that funds collected or received
- 45 thereunder shall be used for specific purposes.

46 All moneys, excepted as aforesaid, shall be paid into the state treasury in the same manner as collections not so 47 excepted, and shall be carried in separate accounts to be 48 49 used and expended only for the purposes for which the 50 same are authorized to be collected by law. The gross amount collected in all cases shall be paid into the state 51 treasury, and commissions, costs and expenses of collec-52 tion authorized by general law to be paid out of the gross collection are hereby authorized to be paid out of the 54 55 moneys collected and paid into the state treasury in the same manner as other payments are made from the state 56 57 treasury. The official or employee making such deposits in the 58 state treasury shall prepare such deposit lists in triplicate 59 in such manner and upon such report forms as may be 60 61 prescribed by the commissioner of finance and administration. The original of this report shall accompany the de-62 posit to the treasurer's office: Certified or receipted copies 63 shall be immediately forwarded by the official or employee making such deposit to the state auditor and to the com-66 missioner of finance and administration, and a copy shall

- 67 be kept by the official or employee making the report and
- 68 shall become a part of his permanent record.
