AN ACT authorizing the city of Wheeling and the board of commissioners of the county of Ohio, to own land in common and to erect, construct, maintain, operate, improve and enlarge a building thereon for housing the offices and other quarters of the various officers and agencies of said city and county, and to enter into an agreement for the joint operation and maintenance of such building.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:


Section 1. *Joint Ownership by City of Wheeling and*
County of Ohio of Land; Erection, Operation and Main-
tenance of Buildings Thereon; Contracts for Joint Opera-
tion and Maintenance of Buildings; Expenditure of Funds;
Bond and Duties of Disbursing Officer.—That the city of
Wheeling and the board of commissioners of the county
of Ohio shall have power to acquire and hold in common


8 land within said city and county and to erect, construct,
9 improve, enlarge, operate, repair and maintain thereon or
10 upon any part thereof a building or buildings for housing
11 the offices and other quarters of the various officers,
12 agencies and employees of said city and county, and to
13 enter into such contracts and agreements with each other
14 as they may mutually approve for the joint operation,
15 management, repair, maintenance and control thereof.
16 Among other provisions, such agreement may create a
17 jointly controlled agency for such operation, management,
18 repair, maintenance and control, with power to contract
19 and expend monies for such purposes to the extent that
20 the same may be made available to such agency by the
21 said city and county, provided that the disbursing officer
22 of such agency shall give bond with solvent surety in
23 such amount as shall be fixed in such agreement con-
24 ditioned for the faithful performance of his duties, the
25 accounting for all funds that may come into his hands or
26 under his control, and upon the termination of his duties,
27 the surrender of all monies in his possession and the
28 delivery of all records pertaining to his office to the proper
29 authorities.

Sec. 2. City and County Authorized to Provide Funds

2 *for Erection, Maintenance and Operation of Buildings;*
3 *Expenses of Agency Created; Transfer of Funds.*—The
4 board of commissioners of the county of Ohio and the
5 city of Wheeling shall have power and authority to pro-
6 vide funds for the payment of all costs of erecting, con-
7 structing, improving, enlarging, operating, repairing,
8 maintaining and managing any building or buildings of
9 the kind mentioned in section one hereof, and the
10 expenses of any agency created by agreement of said
11 county and city for said purposes, and may transfer such
12 funds to such agency in such amounts, in such manner,
13 and at such times as may be provided by mutual agree-
14 ment of said city and county.
